Oklahoma Farm Bureau Young Farmers & Ranchers Scholarship Program 2017

Scholarship specifics

Nine \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded, one per Oklahoma Farm Bureau state board district

Eligibility requirements

- Must be a graduating high school senior.
- Must enroll full time in an agriculture program at an accredited Oklahoma institution of high learning.
- Must be a member of a Farm Bureau family (father, mother or legal guardian memberships qualify; grandparents', siblings' or other relatives' memberships may not be used). Membership must remain in good standing for the duration of the scholarship.
- Children of paid employees of Oklahoma Farm Bureau and Affiliated Companies are not eligible.

Deadline for application

- Applications are available at county Farm Bureau offices or online at the Oklahoma Farm Bureau website at www.okfarmbureau.org/applications.
- Application must be **postmarked no later than April 10, 2017**.

Supporting materials

Applicants must provide the following materials along with the scholarship application:

- A copy of the applicant's official high school transcript
- SAT and/or ACT test scores
- 2 character reference letters, including one who is familiar with applicant's financial status
- A copy of the applicant's resume with activities/honors listed
