WHAT IS OYLA?

Oklahoma Youth Leading Agriculture is a unique five-day summer leadership conference hosted by the Oklahoma Farm Bureau Young Farmers and Ranchers for high school students completing their junior year in 2021. The Oklahoma City-based conference will include special leadership classes, exciting speakers, team building, fellowship, and industry tours. Selected students should be among the top, well rounded students in their class, and should have an interest in furthering their education at the post-secondary level. Students are not required to be Farm Bureau members.

WHEN AND WHERE IS OYLA?

OYLA will be held June 14-18, 2021 in Oklahoma City. Students will be housed together at a local hotel, along with student counselors and OKFB staff. Throughout the conference, OKFB will provide transportation to venues for tours, meals and team building exercises.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

All costs for the conference are covered by the OKFB YF&R Committee.

HOW DO I REGISTER?

OYLA applications are available at county Farm Bureau offices or may be downloaded at okfarmbureau.org/applications. To be considered for the program, applications must be completed and **postmarked no later than May 3, 2021**. Only one student per school will be accepted.

Applicants must provide the following materials along with the conference application:

- A copy of the applicant's current official high school transcript.
- A letter of reference.
- A current, high resolution headshot.
