# 2020 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

## **SCHOLARSHIP SPECIFICS**

Nine \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded, one per Oklahoma Farm Bureau state board district.

### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- Must be a graduating high school senior.
- Must enroll full time in an agriculture program at an accredited Oklahoma college, university or technical school.
- Must be a member of a Farm Bureau family (father, mother or legal guardian memberships qualify; grand-parents', siblings' or other relatives' memberships may not be used). Membership must remain in good standing for the duration of the scholarship.
- Children of paid employees of Oklahoma Farm Bureau and Affiliated Companies are not eligible.

### DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION

- Applications are available at county Farm Bureau offices or online at the Oklahoma Farm Bureau website at www.okfarmbureau.org/applications.
- Application must be emailed or postmarked no later than April 2, 2020.

#### SUPPORTING MATERIALS

Applicants must provide the following materials along with the scholarship application:

- A copy of the applicant's current official high school transcript.
- A copy of the applicant's resume with activities and honors listed.
- Three essays (500 words maximum), double-spaced, typed in Times New Roman, 12-point font.
  - No. 1: Explain your preferred career and describe why you have chosen it.
  - No. 2: How can Farm Bureau encourage young people to engage in agriculture?
  - No. 3: Explain how receiving this scholarship will help you achieve your educational goals.
- Two character reference letters.
